Have you ever pictured in your mind, the image of a person who is being a cheerful giver? The context is, of course, II Corinthians 7:7, and the NLT version actually says, "God loves the person who gives cheerfully!" There has apparently been some confusion about the concept of giving. We pay bills from a sense of duty and responsibility. We owe a certain amount, and pay accordingly. We are compelled to pay or have services cut off. We don't expect a thanks or any special recognition. When we look at our overall budget for any given month, we make allowances for any changes (increases or decreases) and figure out how much we have left for extras. Like dinner and a movie, or a ball game. Or we put it in savings for a special trip next summer! Maybe we'll put some in the offering box at church. See any problems with that scenario?

Let me quote II Corinthians 9:6-7. "Remember this--the farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. You must each make up your own mind as to how much you should give. Don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. For God loves the person who gives cheerfully." Let me invite you to read those next few verses when you get a minute. The 'cheerful giver' means someone who gives with a willing, joyful, and generous heart. Everything we own and possess ultimately belongs to God. We participate in God's mission when we give to the church. No one is looking over your shoulder when you give. But God knows your heart. A cheerful giver is worshipping God.

We don't give expecting anything in return, but He always finds a way to bless our lives. We don't receive a thank-you, but what we do get is an acknowledgment that we have made an eternal investment in the kingdom of God. I honestly think we look at the world expecting a God-sighting! So that mental image of a 'cheerful giver' might take on a whole new meaning!

The Jeus Film Project is a Christian ministry, part of Cru (formerly Campus Crusade for Christ), that uses films and other media to share the story of Jesus with people worldwide. They offer a large library of free online films and resources, translated into over 2,000 languages, with the goal of helping people in all cultures understand and respond to the Christian message. The project was founded in 1981 to distribute the popular JESUS film, and has since expanded its offerings to include short films, digital tools, apps, and even ministry strategies to reach new audiences, especially in areas with limited access to the gospel.
